



Dear Parent,

You are receiving this letter because your child will be entering our 3 -year- old program in the fall. We are so grateful that you have chosen to Love, Learn, and Grow with us another year!

As stated in our handbook, all 3-year-old children must be potty trained to begin in our older classes. We wanted to let each family know, so that you will have plenty of time to begin working with your child.

3-year-old children will be expected to independently use the restroom, wipe, and wash their hands. There will be scheduled potty breaks throughout the day, however children need to be able to verbalize to the teacher if they need to use the restroom between breaks. Children need to wear underwear to school each day. A pullup can be worn during rest time, if needed.

Teachers will assist students with buttons and snaps!

We understand that accidents happen! Please be sure to send extra clothes and underwear each day in your child's school bag.

If it is apparent that your child is not fully trained, we do reserve the right to ask you not to return to school until his/her training is complete. If this occurs, you will still be responsible for paying monthly tuition if you wish to keep your child enrolled in LRP.

If your child has a medical reason that they are delayed in potty training, please bring us a signed doctor's diagnosis explaining the situation.

We want each child to have a fun and rewarding time in the classroom. We do not wish any child to feel shame or embarrassment because they are not potty trained like their peers.
